New Musical on the Horizon:

"Once Upon a One More Time" is a musical that turns the stories of beloved fairy tale characters - including Cinderella, Snow White, and Little Mermaid - upside down when The O.F.G. (Original Fairy Godmother) gives them a copy of "The Feminine Mystique" at their book club and changes the course of their stories.

Fun fact: The music includes songs from Britney Spears! The production will officially open on June 22nd.

"Wicked" Surpasses "Cats":

After the April 11th evening performance, "Wicked" will become the 4th longest-running Broadway show in history, which will surpass "Cats."

With "Wicked" replacing "Cats" as the 4th longest-running Broadway show, all top four shows will be current running shows... until #1's "Phantom of the Opera" plays its final performance on April 16th.

Because the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th shows are set to continue to run, they are in contention to surpass "Phantom's" 13,891 shows, but it will definitely take some time before that happens.

Chicago is the current 2nd longestrunning show, followed by "The Lion King" (3rd), "Wicked" (4th), "Cats" (5th), "Les Miserables" (6th), "A Chorus Line" (7th), "Oh Calcutta!" (8th), "Mamma Mia!" (9th), and "Beauty and the Beast" (10th).


