

TERMINOLOGY



ACROSS:

2. A group of singers and/or dancers performing as a unit; group singing or dancing; a song or part of a song to be sung by more than one person.
5. A seating area above the orchestra section of the auditorium.
7. A period between acts, when the houselights are brought up, and the audience is encouraged to move into the lobby, outside, etc.
8. A piece of scenic canvas, painted or plain, that is flown or fixed to hang in a vertical position.
11. A try-out hearing, usually competitive, of an actor or other performers seeking employment or to be cast in a play.
12. A notification of a working session.

DOWN:

1. One who designs (and often directs) the dances and stage movement in a musical production.
3. A principal role, opposed to that of the protagonist or hero.
4. Another name for "script".
6. The part of the theatre accommodating the audience during the performance. Sometimes known as the "house."
9. The last song, the closing ensemble of a musical production.
10. A passage through the seating area.



A North American tour of the new Broadway musical "Some Like It Hot" will begin in the fall of 2024. The musical recently earned 13 Tony nominations, including Best Musical, rendering it the most Tony-nominated production of the 2022-2023 season.

Set in Chicago when Prohibition has everyone thirsty for a little excitement, "Some Like It Hot" is the "glorious, big, high-kicking" (Associated Press) story of two musicians forced to flee the Windy City after witnessing a mob hit.

3.) When performances don't go as planned, view it as a gift, for that forces you to be in the moment.


