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

MAY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS Our next meeting is Monday June 5 at 7 p.m.


- Revisions to the bylaws will be presented at our next meeting. If there are no objections, we will vote on them in July.

- 11.. A try-out hearing, usually competitive, of an actor or other performers seeking employment or to be cast in a play.
- 12. A notification of a working session.

- 1. One who designs (and often directs) the dances and stage movement in a musical production.
- 3. A principal role, opposed to that of the protagonist or hero.
- 4. Another name for "script".
- 6. The part of the theatre accommodating the audience during the performance. Sometimes known as the "house."
- 9. The last song, the closing ensemble of a musical production.
- 10. A passage through the seating area.





"New York, New York" Album:

The Tony Award-nominated new musical "New York, New York" will release an original Broadway cast recording. The digital version will become available on June 9 on the label Wine & Peaches. Physical CD and vinyl versions of the album are set to be released later this year.

"Some Like It Hot" to Launch North American Tour:

A North American tour of the new Broadway musical "Some Like It Hot" will begin in the fall of 2024. The musical recently earned 13 Tony nominations, including Best Musical, rendering it the most Tony-nominated production of the 2022-2023 season.

Set in Chicago when Prohibition has everyone thirsty for a little excitement, "Some Like It Hot" is the "glorious, big, high-kicking" (Associated Press) story of two musicians forced to flee the Windy City after witnessing a mob hit.
